

Responsibilities: NDIS and FACS

NDIS

Reasonable and Necessary NDIS Supports

Funding disability-specific family supports, which are required due to the impact of the CYP's impairment/s on their functional capacity, including parents with disability

Disability-specific and carer parenting training programs both for the child with disability or the parent with disability

Funding for reasonable and necessary disability support needs of CYP with disability in OOHC where these supports are required due to the impact of the CYP's impairments on their functional capacity, and are additional to the needs of CYP of similar ages, including: skills and capacity building, supports to enable sustainable caring arrangements, home modifications, therapeutic and behaviour support, equipment and transport needs

The coordination of NDIS supports with the systems providing child protection and family supports and other relevant service systems. This includes services which aim to support people experiencing or exiting family violence

Child Protection and Family Support

FACS

Accepting, assessing and responding to reports on **child protection issues**

Community awareness of children's safety and wellbeing

Responsibility to place children in OOHC arrangements as well as arranging and providing the standard supports to sustain those OOHC arrangements

Child protection statutory requirements

Family support, including general supports for families where a parent has a disability

Accommodation needs of CYP in OOHC including the purchase and maintenance of any capital assets such as housing, care allowances and payments

Universal parenting programs in association with family support, Health and Education sectors

Intensive case coordination where a significant component of case coordination is **related to child protection and family support and/or related to issues associated with family violence**
