Long Term Care	Promotes stability and healing for a child who needs to remain in long term statutory OOHC.	\$11,308	Annual payment for the required period	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Case plan goal package review (min every 12 months) Genealogy/family and community connection Ongoing Cultural Care planning as part of case plan reviews Victim of Crime support and referral (if applicable) Family contact, including the development of a contact plan that supports regular positive connections between the child, birth family and siblings Therapeutic life story work <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Carer training in child-specific trauma informed practice Behavioural support plans developed by a specialist Respite Health and Education plans developed within 30 days of entry to care Family Finding to identify long term placement options Interpreter or language services as needed Support of Children's Court proceedings <p>Comment: The case plan goal is to be reviewed annually and alternative permanency outcomes, including restoration, guardianship or adoption are to be considered – this activity has been incorporated into this package.</p>
