<i>Will the plan help the person to have more positive control over their life?</i>		
<i>Does it tell us who was involved in the process and who else has contributed?</i>		
<i>Was there input from family/friends and other people in the person's life?</i>		
<i>Was there collaboration with any other services that also support the person?</i>

<i>Is the plan respectful to the person?</i>		
<i>Is it clear and detailed enough that you understand what is meant by the information? Would new staff know how to work well with the person - Is there clear information about what others need to know and do to support the person?</i>		
<i>Is the plan in a format that makes sense to the person? If not, is there a copy developed for the person with this in mind?</i>		
<i>Does the plan include opportunities for community participation/ inclusion?</i>		
<i>Does the plan capture what's important to the person?</i>		
<i>- relationships, rituals and routines, things they like to do, places they like to go, pace of life, culture and spirituality?</i>		
<i>Does the plan share things that are important to the person in the future? (Goals, dreams, new things the person wants to try).</i>
