This overview supports the business rules for the eligibility criteria of PSP service packages.

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To support a child or young person's needs. The Child Needs Package is based on the outcome of the Child Assessment Tool (CAT) which will identify the therapeutic needs of a child as low, medium or high. While the services provided across low, medium and high needs children are largely the same, they differ in intensity. Child Needs Packages are mutually exclusive.
